

Use a proxy server with the piplanning app

If your outgoing traffic is going over a proxy server in your network, you have to pass this server along to the piplanning app.

Set the Proxy-URL inside the app (>=1.9.4.1.1)

You can set the Proxy URL inside the app by doing the following:

1. Start the piplanning app
2. Press F1 (on macOS you may have to use the 'fn'+F1 combination)
3. In the setting panel click on 'HTTPS Proxy'
4. Input the URL to your Proxy server in the following format: <http://url:port> and click okay
 - a. You can also use `https://`
 - b. Please make sure that you also specify the port

 It might also work without "http(s)://" at all.

5. restart the app

Local proxy (when using authentication)

Tip: If using your networks proxy server directly does not work, you could try installing a local proxy server which connects to your network proxy. Connect then your piplanning app to the local proxy. (CNTLM proxy)

(Deprecated) How to set the environment variable on Windows

- The name of the variable has to be: **https_proxy**
- The format of the value must be of type: „**http(s)://url:port**“
